#### 1.1.1 Oath of Office

### I. POLICY

It is the policy of the Johnstown Police Department to have all sworn members adhere and subscribe to the oath of office. Each member of the Johnstown Police Department, prior to assuming sworn status is required to take and subscribe to an oath of office.

## II. PURPOSE

To provide the officers of the Johnstown Police Department a clear understanding of the law enforcement agency role, the significance and the solemnity of the oath of office and the importance of comprehending and adhering to the oath of office.

## III. PROCEDURE

#### A. Standard

- 1. Said oath shall at a minimum include the language, "I do solemnly swear or affirm that I will support, obey, and defend the constitution of the United States, and the Constitution of this Commonwealth, and I will enforce the laws of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania and the ordinances of the Johnstown Police Department, and that I will discharge the duties of my office with fidelity".
- 2. In this oath, sworn officers shall acknowledge that they will uphold, obey and enforce the law without consideration to a person's race, color, creed, or condition.
- 3. This oath will be administered orally by the Mayor of Johnstown. A signed and notarized copy will be placed in the officer's personnel file. In the absence of the Mayor, the City Manager or Chief of Police may administer the oath of office.
- 4. Any person failing or refusing to take this oath shall be discharged immediately by the proper appointing authority. All newly hired officers will be on a one-year probationary period. This probationary period will commence from the date the officer takes the oath of office.
