A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF JOHNSTOWN, CAMBRIA COUNTY PENNSYLVANIA, AUTHORIZING THE INTERIM CITY MANAGER AND/OR HIS DESIGNEE TO EXECUTE AN AGREEMENT WITH PASSPORT LABS, INC. TO PROVIDE SERVICES AND LICENSE SOFTWARE, INCLUDING ALL WEB AND MOBILE APPLICATIONS TO OPERATE A MOBILE PAYMENT FOR PARKING PROGRAM WHICH ALLOWS ALL PARKING CUSTOMERS IN ANY PARKING FACILITIES OWNED BY THE CITY OF JOHNSTOWN THE ABILITY TO PAY FOR PARKING USING SMARTPHONE APPLICATION OR MOBILE WEB APPLICATION

WHEREAS, it is understood that the Parking Customer will pay a \$.25 per transaction fee for the use of this service; and

WHEREAS, the City of Johnstown will pay \$.20 Gateway and Secure transaction fee per transaction for the use of this service; and

WHEREAS, the City of Johnstown will pay 2.70% of each total transaction paid thru the mobile app, as a credit card transaction fee; and

WHEREAS, the City of Johnstown will pay an annual service and license annual subscription fee of \$12,450.00; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the City Council of Johnstown, Cambria County, Pennsylvania, that the Interim City Manager and/or his designee is directed and authorized to take any/all actions necessary to enter into an agreement with Passport Labs, Inc. for the installation and servicing of a mobile application for parking in the City of Johnstown.





RESOLUTION NO. 10476**

A RESOLUTION OF CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF JOHNSTOWN, CAMBRIA COUNTY PENNSYLVANIA, AUTHORIZING THE INTERIM CITY MANAGER AND HIS DESIGNEES TO SIGN ALL DOCUMENTS AND TAKE ANY/ALL OTHER ACTIONS NECESSARY TO EFFECTUATE THE PURCHASE OF TWO (2) POLICE VEHICLES FOR THE POLICE DEPARTMENT VIA A LEASE-TO-OWN MUNICIPAL FLEET FINANCING AGREEMENT.

WHEREAS, the City of Johnstown Police Department requires replacement of two police vehicles due to the aged and high mileage of these vehicles; and

WHEREAS, a thorough search and review of pricing for the needed vehicles identified Laurel Auto Group, Inc. as offering the lowest (COSTAR) quotes for all vehicles. The cost of the two police vehicles is \$65,200. Equipment will be installed in each vehicle by Team Force, Inc. at a cost of \$12,600 per vehicle for a total cost of equipment of \$25,200; and

WHEREAS, the City has identified the most favorable means to purchase said vehicles as consisting of a four (4) year Municipal Fleet Lease-to-Own Agreement with First Capital Equipment Leasing Corp, in which the total amount of \$90,400 will be financed at an interest rate of 4.438%, wherein the City will make quarterly payments in the amount of \$6,169.56 beginning January 15, 2022; and

WHEREAS, the payment for purchase of these vehicles has been budgeted within the Capital Fund of the City's 2022 Annual Budget, from which the quarterly payments shall be comprised of payment made for the purchase of the police vehicles and related police gear from account no. 18.410.72.016.00.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the City Council of the City of Johnstown, Cambria County, Pennsylvania, that the Interim City Manager and/or his designees are hereby authorized to sign all documents and take any/all other actions necessary to purchase these two police vehicles as described above.



A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF JOHNSTOWN,
PENNSYLVANIA AUTHORIZING THE INTERIM CITY MANAGER
AND/OR HIS DESIGNEE TO TAKE ANY AND ALL ACTIONS
NECESSARY TO EFFECTUATE AN INTERGOVERNMENTAL AGREEMENT TO
PROVIDE POLICE SERVICES IN LORAIN BOROUGH EFFECTIVE
JANUARY 1, 2022 THROUGH DECEMBER 31, 2026.

WHEREAS, Cities and Boroughs are authorized to enter into any joint agreements as may be deemed appropriate in the exercise or in the performance of their respective governmental functions, powers or responsibilities in accordance with the Pennsylvania Intergovernmental Cooperation Law (53 Pa. C.S. §2301 et seq.); and

WHEREAS, the Borough of Lorain has requested that the City provide police services to the Borough; and

WHEREAS, the City is agreeable to providing said police services to the Borough in accordance with the terms and conditions of the Intergovernmental Agreement attached hereto.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the City Council of the City of Johnstown, Pennsylvania, that the Interim City Manager is hereby authorized and directed to take any and all actions necessary to effectuate said Intergovernmental Agreement, in the form attached hereto and incorporated herein, to provide police services to Lorain Borough for a five-year period beginning on January 1, 2022 and expiring December 31, 2026.
