# 4.1.2 Vehicle Pursuit Reporting

#### I. POLICY

It is the policy of the Johnstown Police Department to comply with sections 6341 – 6345 of the Pennsylvania Vehicle Code [Title 75] in regard to the reporting and recording requirements for pursuit vehicles.

#### II. PURPOSE

The policy provides personnel with guidelines on motor vehicle pursuit reporting, as required by law. Act 154 of 1994 requires police departments in Pennsylvania to make a record of all vehicle pursuits and to report them to the Pennsylvania State Police.

#### III. PROCEDURES

#### A. Mandated Policy

1. The Johnstown Police Department shall develop and implement a written emergency vehicle response policy governing the procedures under which a police officer should initiate, continue and terminate a motor vehicle pursuit. [See policy 2.1]

# B. Pursuit Documentation and Reporting

- 1. The Johnstown Police Department shall maintain records of all motor vehicle pursuits. Whenever an officer engages in a motor vehicle pursuit, the Captain of Police shall complete the current Pennsylvania Police Pursuit Report.
- 2. The Captain of Police shall determine if the officer complied with the pursuit policy. He/she shall detect and correct any training deficiencies discovered. He/she will submit the pursuit reports to the Pennsylvania State Police, Bureau of Research and Development. The Captain of Police shall maintain copies of all motor vehicle pursuit reports.
- 3. Whenever an officer engages in a motor vehicle pursuit, the officer shall document all pertinent information in an incident report. The report shall include, but not limited to, the following information:
  - a. Reason for pursuit.
  - b. Injuries, if any and to what persons.
  - c. Deaths, if any and to what persons.

- d. Property damage, if any.
- e. Suspect information, including statute violations and apprehension status of the suspect.
- f. Route of the pursuit, time and distance.
- g. Any other information necessary for a complete detailed report.

# C. Review

The Johnstown Police Department shall periodically analyze police pursuit activity and identify any additions, deletions or modifications warranted in departmental pursuit procedures.
