





A RESOLUTION OF CITY COUNCIL, OF THE CITY OF JOHNSTOWN, PENNSYLVANIA AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO SIGN A CONTRACT WITH WITMER PUBLIC SAFETY GROUP, INC. THE FIRESTORE, 430W. KING STREET ABBOTTSTOWN, PA 17301 TO PROVIDE AND DELIVER TO THE CITY TURNOUT GEAR FOR THE JOHNSTOWN FIRE DEPARTMENT.

WHEREAS, a FEMA Grant was awarded on the behalf of the Department of Homeland Security under the Fiscal Year (FY) 2014 Assistance to Firefighters Grant in the amount of \$77,490.00; and

WHEREAS, as a condition of this award, the City must contribute a cost match in the amount of \$7,748.00 of non-Federal funds, or 10 percent of the Federal contribution; and

WHEREAS, the City obtained COSTARS pricing through a COSTARS supplier to ensure the best value through an interactive partnership with the Commonwealth; and

WHEREAS, Witmer Public Safety Group, Inc. The Firestore provided the City with a COSTARS pricing of \$86,632.00, with an option of adding an escape belt to each pant (34) at an additional cost of \$95.00 each.



WHEREAS, the United States Department of Environmental Protection Agency has Assessment Grants available to fund inventory, characterize, assess and conduct planning and community involvement related to brownfield sites; and

WHEREAS, the City of Johnstown requires assessment and plans related to brownfield sites throughout the City in order to entice economic development;

WHEREAS, the U.S. Department of Environmental Protection Agency is accepting Brownfields Assessment Grant application up to \$400,000; and

WHEREAS, the City of Johnstown is desirous of obtaining a Brownfield Assessment Grant in the amount of \$400,000.


