A RESOLUTION OF THE GOVERNING BOARD OF CITY OF JOHNSTOWN, PENNSYLVANIA, AUTHORIZING, EMPOWERING AND DIRECTING THE PROPER OFFICERS OF THE GOVERNING BOARD TO APPOINT A LIAISON BETWEEN IT AND BERKHEIMER, THE DULY APPOINTED COLLECTOR OF LOCAL TAXES FOR THE DISTRICT, FOR THE EXPRESS PURPOSE OF SHARING CONFIDENTIAL TAX INFORMATION WITH THE DISTRICT FOR OFFICIAL PURPOSES.

WHEREAS, Act No. 511 of the 1965 General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania (53 P.S. §690l et seq.), enacted December 31, 1965, and effective January 1, 1966, authorizes certain political subdivisions, including CITY OF JOHNSTOWN, to provide for the creation of such bureaus or the appointment and compensation of such officers, clerks, collectors and other assistants and employees as may be deemed necessary for the assessment and collection of taxes imposed under the authority of that Act; and

WHEREAS, CITY OF JOHNSTOWN, has entered into contractual agreement with BERKHEIMER of Bangor, Pennsylvania, whereby and whereunder CITY OF JOHNSTOWN appointed Berkheimer to collect certain local taxes; and

WHEREAS, said Act 511 specifically mandates that any information gained by the appointed tax officer, his agents or by any other official or agent of the taxing district, as a result of any declarations, returns, investigations, hearings or verifications required or authorized by the taxing municipality's ordinance or resolution, be kept confidential, except for official purposes; and

WHEREAS, any person who divulges any information which is confidential under the provisions of any ordinance or resolution, upon conviction may be subject to fines and/or imprisonment, upon conviction, and dismissal from office or discharge from employment; and

WHEREAS, Berkheimer requires passage of a resolution by the governing body of CITY OF JOHNSTOWN, specifying that said confidential information is needed for official purposes and absolving Berkheimer from any liability in connection with the release of said confidential information;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that:

- 1. CITY OF JOHNSTOWN, hereby appoints Stephen Keith as its authorized representative to make requests upon and receive any and all tax information and records from Berkheimer, relative to the collection of taxes for CITY OF JOHNSTOWN, as desired and deemed necessary by CITY OF JOHNSTOWN, to be used for official purposes only; and
- 2. Berkheimer is hereby directed to provide and/or transmit any and all tax information and records, or any portion thereof, relating to the collection of taxes for the CITY OF JOHNSTOWN, upon request, to Stephen Keith as the authorized contact representative for it.
- 3. **CITY OF JOHNSTOWN,** hereby saves harmless, indemnifies and/or absolves Berkheimer from and against any and all liability in connection with the release of said confidential information.

RESOLUTION NO. 9881

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF JOHNSTOWN PENNSYLVANAIA AUTHORIZING THE INTERIM CITY MANAGER TO PROCEED WITH ACCEPTING THE TERMS OF THE CONSOLIDATING LOAN AS PROPOSED BY FIRST SUMMIT BANK IN THEIR TERM SHEET SUMMARY DATED AUGUST 24, 2016.

WHEREAS, The City of Johnstown has accumulated deficits as reported in the December 31, 2015 financial statement audit in excess of \$3,000,000.

WHEREAS, The City of Johnstown has outstanding debt eligible to be refinanced of approximately \$3,100,000, which consists of a parking note, capital leases and a capital line of credit.

WHEREAS, First Summit Bank summited a proposal to issue a cumulative loan in the aggregate amount of \$6,000,000 to refinance the existing obligations eligible to be refinanced and provide the necessary funds to meet expected year-end obligations

WHEREAS, The terms of the note proposed by First Summit Bank is for a period of ten (10) years at a fixed rate of 2.65%.

WHEREAS, The final issuance of the note is subject to approval from Pennsylvania Department of Community and Economic Development, Court Approval, final approval from First Summit Bank and the appropriate documentation, applications and advertisement by the City Solicitor and First Summit Bank's Legal Council.

WHEREAS, The anticipated closing date is on or around November 15, 2016.

NOW THEREFORE IT BE RESOLVED, that the City of Johnstown and the Interim City Manager and Solicitor are hereby authorized to submit and sign the necessary documents and applications with First Summit Bank, County of Cambria Court of Common Pleas and Pennsylvania Department of Community and Economic Development as necessary to complete the transaction.

This Resolution shall be effective in accordance with the Act and any other required approvals.
