ORDINANCES FOR FIRST READ

1. BILL NO. 20 OF 2016 AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING “THE ETHICS CODE OF THE CITY OF JOHNSTOWN, PENNSYLVANIA, FOR ALL ELECTED AND APPOINTED OFFICIALS, AND APPOINTEES TO AGENCIES BY JOHNSTOWN CITY COUNCIL, BY ESTABLISHING STANDARDS OF CONDUCT FOR ALL ELECTED OFFICIALS, MEMBERS OF BOARDS, AUTHORITIES AND COMMISSIONS OF THE CITY OF JOHNSTOWN, THE CITY MANAGER, ASSISTANT CITY MANAGER AND DEPARTMENT HEADS AND CITY EMPLOYEES ESTABLISHING THE “CITY OF JOHNSTOWN’S ETHICS’ COMMISSION”*
2. BILL NO. 21 OF 2016 AN ORDINANCE CREATING A LOAN REVIEW COMMITTEE, AND ESTABLISHING PROCEDURES FOR THE APPROVAL OF ALL ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT LOANS ADMINISTERED BY THE CITY’S DEPARTMENT OF COMMUNITY & ECONOMIC; AND POLICIES FOR WRITING-OFF OF LOANS DEEMED TO BE UNCOLLECTABLE , AND ESTABLISHING A LOAN REVIEW COMMITTEE BOARD CONSISTING OF (7) SEVEN MEMBERS AS RECOMMENDED BY THE CITY MANAGER, AND CONFIRMED BY CITY COUNCIL FOR TERMS OF (3) THREE YEARS; AND FURTHER BY ESTABLISHING: CHAPTER 295 LOAN REVIEW COMMITTEE UNDER TITLE EIGHT: BOARDS AUTHORITIES AND COMMISSION OF THE CODIFIED ORDINANCES OF THE CITY OF JOHNSTOWN.*

3. BILL NO. 22 OF 2016 AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 5192, passed finally on December 22, 2015, titled: AN ORDINANCE ESTIMATING THE AMOUNT OF REVENUES TO BE RECEIVED BY THE CITY OF JOHNSTOWN FROM VARIOUS SOURCES AND APPROPRIATING SPECIFIC SUMS ESTIMATED TO BE REQUIRED FOR SPECIFIC PURPOSES FOR THE OPERATIONS OF THE VARIOUS FUNDS, BUREAUS, DEPARTMENTS, AND THE PAYMENT OF DEBT SERVICE AND PENSION FUND OBLIGATIONS OF THE CITY OF JOHNSTOWN, PENNSYLVANIA, FOR THE CALENDAR YEAR BEGINNING JANUARY 1, 2016, INCLUDING THE FOLLOWING CITY OF JOHNSTOWN FUND SECTIONS, AND THE RESPECTIVE FUNDS "BUDGET EXHIBIT A DETAILS", TO CORRECT ERRORS AND OMISSIONS WITH THE AMENDING AND FINAL PASSAGE OF ORDINANCE NO. 5192 ON DECEMBER 22, 2015:*

4. BILL NO. 23 OF 2016 AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 5102 passed 3-38-12, and/or any and all subsequent amendments, and the CODIFIED ORDINANCES OF THE CITY OF JOHNSTOWN; CHAPTER 1484 titled: Residential Rental Property Registration and more specifically, subsection: 1484.05 REGISTRATION AND LICENSING OF RESIDENTIAL RENTAL PROPERTIES, by ADDING subsection. *

RESOLUTIONS
