AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 5322 ADOPTED DECEMBER 8, 2021, AMENDED ON MARCH 9, 2022, AND AMENDING THE SALARIES AND WAGES TO BE PAID TO CERTAIN EMPLOYEES OF THE CITY OF JOHNSTOWN FOR THE CALENDAR YEAR 2022

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Johnstown wishes to increase the hourly rate of Seasonal Part-Time other parks employees who work during the summer from \$8.49 per hour to \$11.00 per hour; and

WHEREAS, this will result in an increase labor cost of \$1,204.80; and

WHEREAS, the small increase in payroll cost does not require a budget amendment.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ENACTED AND ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Johnstown, Pennsylvania, and it is hereby enacted and ordained by the authority of the same:

SECTION 1. Ordinance No. 5322, adopted December 8, 2021 and amended on March 9, 2022 is hereby amended as shown:

SECTION 2. All Ordinances or part in conflict herein are hereby repealed.

SECTION 3. This Ordinance shall become effective April 13, 2022.
