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4 1 P R O C E E D I N G S 2 3 MAYOR JANAKOVIC: I'd like to call to 4 5 order the public hearing for this 6 evening. If you would, Solicitor? 7 ATTORNEY BENJAMIN: 8 Yes. This public 9 hearing is being convened for purposes 10 of accepting public comment on the 11 City of Johnstown's 2019 Budget 12 Ordinance and the 2019 Wage and Salary 1.3 Ordinance, with the Budget Ordinance 14 having been identified as Bill 35 of 15 2018 as amended and the Wage and 16 Salary Ordinance being identified as Bill 36 of 2018 as amended. 17 18 We'll note for the 19 record that the public notice of this 20 hearing was duly advertised on January 5th, 2019 and published within the 21

Tribune Democrat. And the purpose of
the hearing is for the acceptance of
public comment and input on the budget
which has been posted for inspection

5 in compliance with the City's Home 1 2 Rule Charter. 3 And at this time, we can now accept any public comments that 4 5 would be offered. 6 MAYOR JANAKOVIC: 7 Has anyone signed up besides you, Mr. Williams? 8 9 MR. WILLIAMS: 10 A Mr. Stonerook, I guess 11 that's for a meeting? 12 MAYOR JANAKOVIC: 1.3 He's not here? All 14 right. That must be for the meeting 15 then. So if you would, name 16 17 and address for the stenographer? 18 MR. WILLIAMS: 19 Jack Williams 360 20 Corrine Street, Johnstown, 15906. 2.1 Are you ready? 2.2 MAYOR JANAKOVIC: 23 Yes. 2.4 MR. WILLIAMS: 25 Okay. Maybe the third

time's the charm. This is the third

public hearing. I talked with Ms.

Benjamin earlier today, we still have

problems with this budget.

And the handout I made dated the 16th for Bill 35, and I pointed them out. Okay.

We talked about the OPEB, okay, at the last meeting. This is --- the current year, this is what was required by the Recovery Plan to put \$50,000 per year in the unfunded portion. Mr. Ritter was going to be in touch with Recovery Coordinator since the Manager wasn't here. I've received no update. And that \$50,000 is still not in the budget.

The other --- in the general fund, we have --- you have your budgets, line item 700 is sewer reimbursement, okay, and there's a line item in there, 01475 and 0192500 liability/audit/legal, \$100,000. This is improper, okay. That needs to be

where it says recreation grant for Roxbury, \$225,000. Okay? That has no business being in the Point Stadium account, that belongs in capital.

All right?

If you flip the page over, now you're on the expenditure side, line 40, recreation Roxbury, City match, \$31,000. See that?

MAYOR JANAKOVIC:

Uh-huh (yes).

MR. WILLIAMS:

Going down --- if you go on down further, okay, I think most of us are aware that the Point Stadium is being subsidized by the general fund because it has not generated enough revenue.

All right?

The other thing that
this budget does not include --- back
to page one, turf management fees,
zero, all right? Point Stadium
advertising, all right, zero, all
right? Now we have the Sargent's,

okay, which if you look at your December 2018 monthly financial report, it shows an \$800 payment through December.

Point being if you look at those ones that have --- it's recreation. For some ungodly reason the administration put Roxbury grant and expenses into fund 22. And I'll give you an example of why it's capital, Mrs. Mock, you'd be aware of this, when the Oakhurst Playground was done, do you recall what your net was?

MR. WILLIAMS:

Well, anyhow, if you

look at the capital at that time, those grants --- there was two grants that went into capital and the expenditures came into capital.

This thing here, the 225 coming is a grant at the end of the year. And then the City's match at \$31,000 is further putting the Point

1 | Stadium in deficit balance.

2 All right.

3 So again, this needs to

4 be amended to put that into capital

5 and find a \$31,000 match from some

6 other place in the budget, not the

7 fund 22, someplace in the general fund

8 to meet that match.

9 Are there any questions

10 on that? I know there's a resolution

11 on tonight for awarding the contract

12 to --- for that. And until this

13 budget is adopted properly, that

14 resolution should be tabled.

15 ATTORNEY BENJAMIN:

16 Which resolution, Mr.

17 Williams?

MR. WILLIAMS:

19 I'm sorry?

20 ATTORNEY BENJAMIN:

21 Which resolution are you

22 talking about?

MR. WILLIAMS:

24 The resolution

25 authorizing the execution of a

I have spoken before

24 about breaking the Convention Center

25 | contract. We are not making money off

1 of the Convention Center.

2 I believe that's

3 something that City Council has to

4 begin looking into, ways that we can

5 actually make money off of our

6 resources. If that means we take

7 legal action and break the contract so

it's not so lopsided, that would be a

9 recommendation to the City Council

members.
