**RESOLUTION NO. 10497**

**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF JOHNSTOWN, PENNSYLVANIA ADOPTING AN INVESTMENT PLAN DETAILING THE USE OF FUNDING PROVIDED UNDER THE AMERICAN RESCUE PLAN ACT TO SUPPORT THE CITY OF JOHNSTOWN'S RECOVERY FROM THE COVID 19 PANDEMIC**

**WHEREAS**, the American Rescue Plan Act of 2021 (ARPA) was signed into law by the President of the United States on March 11, 2021; and

**WHEREAS**, ARPA is intended to provide support to local governments in responding to the social, community and economic impacts of the COVID 19 pandemic; and

**WHEREAS**, ARPA includes state and local fiscal recovery funds to support COVID 19 response efforts to decrease the spread of the virus; to replace lost public sector revenue; to strengthen support for vital public services; to support immediate economic stabilization for households and businesses; and to address systemic public health and economic challenges that have contributed to unequal impacts of the pandemic on certain populations; and

**WHEREAS**, the ARPA will provide an estimated \$350 billion in emergency funding directly to state and local governments for the purpose of supporting their recovery from the impacts of the COVID 19 pandemic; and

**WHEREAS**, the City of Johnstown will receive \$30,716,690 from the United States Department of Treasury under the ARPA (ARPA Funds); and

**WHEREAS**, the ARPA Funds must be obligated by the end of 2024 and ultimately spent by the end of 2026; and

**WHEREAS**, the U.S. Department of the Treasury issued the Final Rules for expenditure of the ARPA Funds on January 6, 2022; and

**WHEREAS**, the City Council and City administrative staff actively sought input from City residents, non-profit organizations, local business owners and other local stakeholders on pandemic related community needs; and

**WHEREAS**, based on the foregoing statements, and in accordance with the Final Rule issued by the United States Department of Treasury, the City Council of the City of Johnstown establishes this Investment Plan, included hernein and attached to this Resolution as (Exhibit A) to guide the spending of ARPA Funds.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED**, that the City Manager and/or his designees are hereby authorized and directed to execute, on behalf of the City of Johnstown, the attached


Investment Plan (Exhibit A) to support the City of Johnstown's recovery from the COVID 19 pandemic.

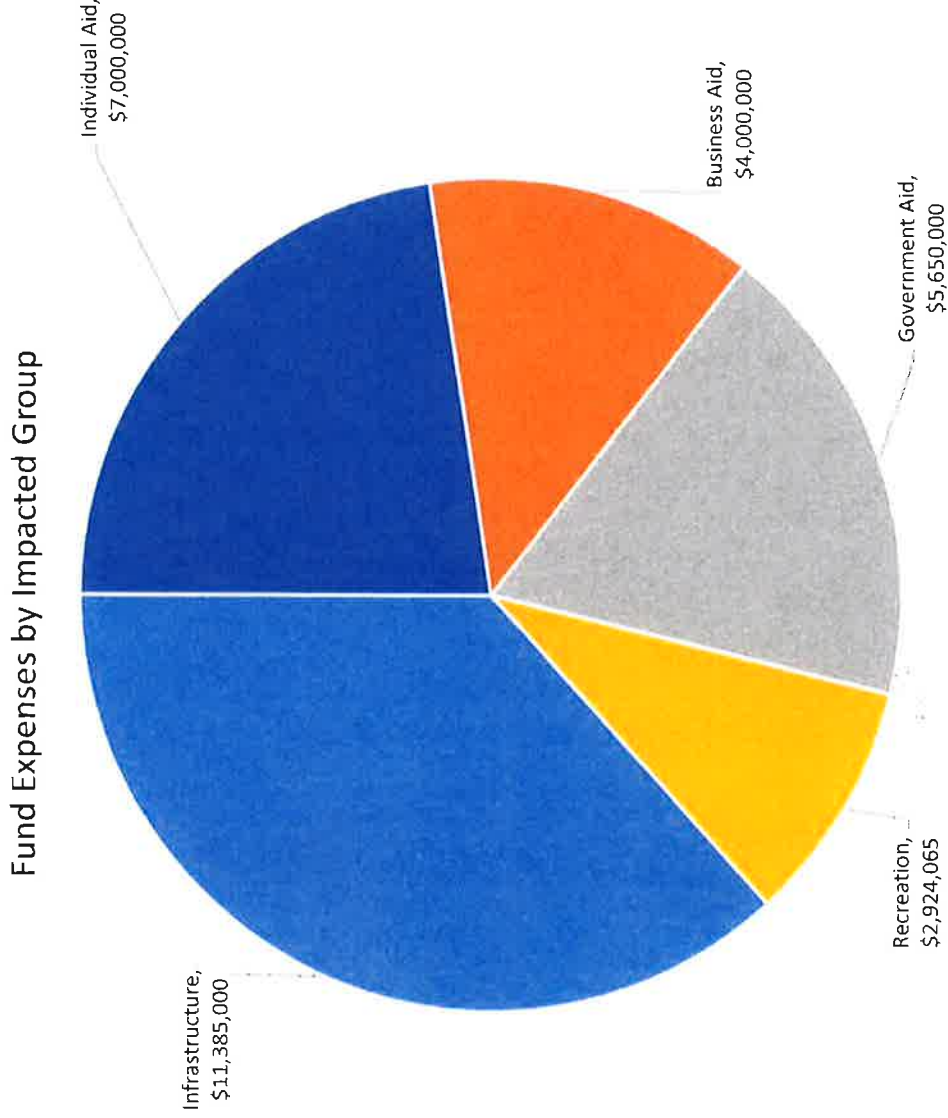
