A RESOLUTION OF CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF JOHNSTOWN, PENNSYLVANIA, AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER AND FINANCE DIRECTOR TO SIGN ALL DOCUMENTS NECESSARY TO PURCHASE A 2023 INTERNATIONAL TRUCK WITH AN ALUMINUM DUMP BODY WITH SNOW EQUIPMENT; AND A 2021 FORD RANGER 4X4 SUPER CAB FOR THE CODE ENFORCEMENT DEPARTMENT

WHEREAS, the City of Johnstown Public Works Department sought pricing and bids to purchase a 2023 International Truck with Aluminum Dump Bed with snow equipment; and

WHEREAS, the City of Johnstown Code Enforcement Department sought pricing and bids to purchase a Ford Ranger 4 x 4 Super Cab; and

WHEREAS, the 2023 Five Star International Truck bid price is \$96,750; and Aluminum Dump Bed with Snow Equipment purchase from A & H Equipment will cost of \$56,083.00. The total cost of the vehicle outfitted for snow removal is \$152,833.00; and

WHEREAS, Suppes Ford offered the lowest quote for the 2021 Ford Ranger Super Cab with a price of \$32,670; and

WHEREAS, the price for both vehicles was obtained through the COSTARS program; and

WHEREAS, both vehicles will be placed on a lease to own agreement with First Capital Equipment Leasing Corporation for a 5-year term; interest rate 3.594%; and

WHEREAS, the new 2023 International Truck will be charged to account number 18.434.74.072.00 and the 2021 Ford Ranger will be charged to account number 01.465.20.060.00.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by City Council of Johnstown, Cambria County, Pennsylvania, that the City Manager and Finance Director are hereby authorized to sign all documents necessary to purchase the 2023 Five Star International Truck and the 2021 Ford Ranger 4x4 Super Cab.
