A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF JOHNSTOWN, CAMBRIA COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA, AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER AND FINANCE DIRECTOR TO SIGN ALL DOCUMENTS AND TAKE ANY/ALL OTHER ACTIONS NECESSARY IN THE PURCHASE AN AMKUS HYDRALIC RESCUE TOOL AND DEWALT POWER TOOLS FROM FIRE RESCUE PRODUCTS

WHEREAS, the City of Johnstown Fire Department requires replacement of hydraulic rescue tools and battery power tools for the purpose of preforming vehicle and industrial rescue operations within the city of Johnstown. The current hydraulic rescue tool and battery power tools is being replaced due to changes in vehicle construction and changes in NFPA standards which limits the effectiveness of the current hydraulic tools. Replacement of the Hydraulic Rescue Tool and Battery Power Tool System was budgeted for in the Capital Improvement Plan; and

WHEREAS, purchase of this Hydraulic Rescue Tool and Battery Power Tools will be made from the Capital Fund, Account No. 18.412.74.489.00; and

WHEREAS, through search and testing for Hydraulic Rescue Tool and Battery Power Tools, Fire Rescue Products offered the lowest (COSTAR) quote for and AMKUS Rescue Tool and DeWalt Battery Power Tools at \$21,127.83.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the City Council of Johnstown, Cambria County, Pennsylvania, that the City Manager and Finance Director are hereby authorized to sign all documents and take any/all other actions necessary to purchase said AMKUS Hydraulic Rescue Equipment and DeWalt Battery Powered Tools from Fire Rescue Product at a cost of \$21,127.83.
