RESOLUTION NO. 10521**

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF JOHNSTOWN, PENNSYLVANIA AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO SIGN ALL DOCUMENTS NECESSARY TO EXECUTE AN AGREEMENT WITH QUAKER SALES CORPORATION AWARDED CONTRACT 2022-04 MISCELLANEOUS PAVING PROJECT (SUPPES AVENUE, HAMMER AVENUE, TILLMAN AVENUE, BRUSH AVENUE, DUWELL STREET, HOFFMAN AVENUE, EFFIE ALLEY, GREGG AVENUE, SEMINARY LANE, LINCOLN STREET, LOCUST STREET, MARKET STREET, JACKSON STREET, AND MAIN STREET)

WHEREAS, the EADS Group Inc on behalf of the City of Johnstown advertised and opened bids for Contract 2022-04 Miscellaneous Paving Project; and

WHEREAS, the contract was advertised in a paper of general circulation and the bids were opened at 10:00 a.m. on August 31, 2022; and

WHEREAS, Quaker Sales Corporation is the apparent low bidder for contract 2022-04 Miscellaneous Paving Project, with a Total Base Bid of \$533,239.90; and

WHEREAS, the City administration recommends that City Council accepts the attached proposal for said work, in the amount of \$533,239.90. The Miscellaneous Paving Project will be paid from the Capital Fund, Account number 18.434.37.544.00; and

WHEREAS, approval of an agreement based on the acceptance of the above-referenced proposal shall be and is hereby made contingent upon final review and approval of all applicable terms and conditions by the City Solicitor.

NOW, THEREFORE, be it resolved by the City Council of the City of Johnstown, Pennsylvania, the City Manager is authorized to sign all documents necessary to award Contract Number 2022-04 to Quaker Sales Corporation to pave portions of the following streets: Suppes Avenue, Hammer Avenue, Tillman Avenue, Brush Avenue, Duwell Street, Hoffman Avenue, Effie Alley, Gregg Avenue, Seminary Lane, Lincoln Street, Locust Street, Market Street, Jackson Street and Main Street.


