**RESOLUTION NO. 10525**

**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF JOHNSTOWN, PENNSYLVANIA AUTHORIZING AND DIRECTING THE CITY MANAGER TO SIGN A WINTER TRAFFIC SERVICES AGREEMENT WITH THE COMMONWEALTH OF PENNSYLVANIA THROUGH THE PENNSYLVANIA DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION FOR THE WINTER SEASONS OF 2022-2023; 2023-2024; 2024-2025; 2025-2026; and 2026-2027**

**WHEREAS**, the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, through its Department of Transportation, has control and maintenance responsibilities for certain public highways and bridges within the corporate limits of the City of Johnstown; and

**WHEREAS**, the City has the ability, personnel, equipment and materials to remove snow and ice from these public highways in a prompt and efficient manner; and

**WHEREAS**, the Pennsylvania Department of Transportation desires to enter into an agreement for snow removal and de-icing services with the City of Johnstown for the winter seasons of 2022-2023; 2023-2024; 2024-2025; 2025-2026; and 2026-2027; and

**WHEREAS**, the City Council of the City of Johnstown desires to enter into the said agreement with the Pennsylvania Department of Transportation.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED**, by the City Council of the City of Johnstown, Pennsylvania, that the City Manager is hereby authorized and directed to renew the Winter Traffic Services Agreement with the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, Department of Transportation for the winter seasons of 2022-2023; 2023-2024; 2024-2025; 2025-2026; and 2026-2027.
