A RESOLUTION OF CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF JOHNSTOWN, PENNSYLVANIA, AUTHORIZING ACTING CITY MANAGER DESIGNEES AS PROVIDED FOR IN SECTION 604 OF THE HOME RULE CHARTER

WHEREAS, Section 604 of the City of Johnstown Home Rule Charter provides for the designation of Acting City Manager designees; and

WHERAS, Acting City Manager designees will be available if the City Manager is unable to perform the duties of that office, whether because of absence or disability; and

WHEREAS, Section 604 of the Home Rule Charter states the City Manager may delegate such authority to another Municipal employee, subject to prior approval by Council.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the City Council of Johnstown, Cambria County, Pennsylvania, that the City Manager may designate the Assistant City Manager, Director of Community and Economic Development, Director of Public Works or the Director of Finance as Acting City Manager in the event the City Manager is unable to perform the duties of that office, whether because of absence or disability.
