**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED**, by the City Council of the City of Johnstown, Pennsylvania, that the Employment Agreement of Daniel Penatzer as Interim City Manager is hereby extended on a week-to-week basis under the same terms and conditions as expressed in the original Employment Agreement, until such time that a permanent appointment is effective or until either party terminates the Agreement.
