RESOLUTION NO. 10490**

**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF JOHNSTOWN,
PENNSYLVANIA, AUTHORIZING AND DIRECTING THE CITY MANAGER
TO EXECUTE A CHANGE ORDER TO A CONTRACT BETWEEN THE
JOHNSTOWN REDEVELOPMENT AUTHORITY AND TERRA WORKS, INC.
IN THE AMOUNT OF \$1,995,729.50 FOR THE REPLACEMENT OF THE
STORMWATER SYSTEM ALONG FAIRFIELD AVENUE**

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Johnstown has previously adopted Resolution No. 10445 dated August 11, 2021 approving a Cooperative Agreement with the Johnstown Redevelopment Authority (JRA) for purposes of financing stormwater replacement and rehabilitation work along Fairfield Avenue; and

WHEREAS, said Resolution anticipated a project cost of \$1.5 million for the work outlined in the change order prepared by Terra Works, Inc. as well as any additional repavement costs; and

WHEREAS, the cost of the referenced additional pavement is now known; and

WHEREAS, the City of Johnstown wishes to add various other work components to the change order including catch basins, lateral verification, by-pass pumping and lateral connection; and

WHEREAS, the total adjusted cost of the change order is now \$1,995,729.50 including the amounts originally approved and the additional work described herein.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Johnstown, that the attached Change Order No. 5 in the amount of \$1,995,729.50 authorizing repairs to the Fairfield Avenue stormwater system, to be performed cooperatively with the completion of the JRA's "Fairfield Avenue Interceptor Rehabilitation & Stormwater Separation, ME#75349" contract project, as previously approved in the August 11, 2021 Cooperative Agreement with the Johnstown Redevelopment Authority is hereby approved, and that the City Manager is authorized and directed to sign all documents and take any/all actions necessary to effectuate the change order and the work described therein. 
