WHEREAS, Ligonier Construction is the apparent low bidder for Contract 2022-03, Elk Run Debris Basin Project, with a Total Base Bid of \$213,000.00; and

WHEREAS, approval of an agreement based on the acceptance of the above referenced proposal shall be and is hereby made contingent upon final review and approval of all applicable terms and conditions by the City Solicitor.



I. INTRODUCTION

Bids for Contract No. 2022-03, Elk Run Debris Basin Project for the City of Johnstown were opened at 10:00 A.M., Prevailing Time, September 20, 2022. This Report is presented as our review for the City's award of this Contract.

Refer to Appendix 1 for the Advertisement for Bids and the Bid Tabulation Report of the bids received from the bidders.

II. CONTRACT 2022-03

Bids Received

Nine (9) Contractors purchased plans and specifications; of these plan holders' four (4) of the Contractors submitted bids for Contract 2022-03; refer to Appendix 1 for the Bid Tabulation.

The four (4) Base Bids received from the Contractors ranged in price from \$213,000.00 to \$253,450.00. The average Total Base Bid for Contract 2022-03 was \$235,424.00.

The apparent low bidder for Contract 2022-03 was Ligonier Construction Company for \$213,000.00.

Bid Documents

Attached in Appendix 2 is the Bid Package for Contract 2022-03 that was received from Ligonier Construction Company. All the requested bid documents were received. Ligonier Construction submitted a Bid Bond for 10% of the bid; the Surety Company is *Hudson Insurance Company* and are on the U.S. Treasury Department's most current list (Circular 570, as amended) as required by the Contract Documents.

III. RECOMMENDATION

Ligonier Construction has satisfactorily performed work like this Contract. We have contacted the Bidder and they are confident with their bid prices. Based upon the available funding for this project, we recommend awarding the Bid for Contract No. 2022-03 in the amount of **\$213,000.00** to Ligonier Construction Company.

ADVERTISEMENT FOR BIDS

Sealed Bids for the construction of the Elk Run Debris Basin Project, Contract No. 2022-03 will be received by City of Johnstown (Owner) at their office located at the City of Johnstown Finance Office, City Hall, 401 Main Street, Johnstown, Pennsylvania 15901, until **10:00 A.M.**, prevailing time on **Tuesday, September 20, 2022**, at which time the bids will be publicly opened and read aloud.

Contract Description: Contract No. 2022-03 consists of the removal of sediment from the Elk Run debris basin, and all related work. Work under this contract shall include all materials, equipment, supplies, and labor for the construction as shown and specified in the Contract Documents. The project is located in the City of Johnstown, Cambria County, Pennsylvania.

The Issuing Office for the Bidding Documents is The EADS Group, Inc. (Engineer), 227 Franklin Street, Suite 300, Johnstown, Pennsylvania 15901, telephone no. (814)535-5388. Prospective Bidders may examine the Bidding Documents at the Issuing Office and at the office of the Owner. Contract Documents and Plans are to be purchased from The EADS Group, Inc. for the nonrefundable fee of **\$100.00** for one hard copy set or for the nonrefundable fee of **\$25.00** for the electronic format set of contract documents and plans, both of which includes 6% Pennsylvania sales tax. To access the electronic format the bidder must have a valid email address and will require an internet connection. All checks shall be made payable to "The EADS Group, Inc." Bidders must purchase the Contract Documents and Plans (in either format) from The EADS Group, Inc. to be eligible to bid this project.

The project is being financed in part with a grant provided through the American Rescue Plan Act of 2021. The obligations imposed on the Owner by the financing agency(s) shall apply to and be acceptable to the successful bidder(s). Bidders must comply with all State anti-bid-rigging regulations pertaining to work associated with this project and will be required to submit an executed non-collusion affidavit with the bid.

Bid security shall be furnished in accordance with the Instructions to Bidders. Prior to the award of the contract, the successful bidder shall furnish a satisfactory Performance Bond and a Labor and Material Payment Bond to the Owner, in the form contained in the Contract Documents and executed by a satisfactory circular 570 listed surety, each equal to 100% of the total contract amount. The bidder will also furnish evidence of insurance coverage as required by the contract documents.

Bidders for this contract shall have completed projects similar in character and scope and will be required to provide with their bid a completed Statement of Bidders Qualifications and Equipment List in the forms prescribed in the Contract Documents. The Contractor shall adhere to the provisions of the Pennsylvania Prevailing Wage Rates as set forth in the Contract Documents. The Contractor shall also comply with the provisions of the Act of March 3, 1978 (P.L. 6, No. 3 known as the "Steel Procurement Act").

The successful bidder(s) will be required to complete all work within **60** consecutive calendar days from, and including, the date indicated by the Owner in their written Notice to Proceed.

A pre-bid meeting will be held on site at the Debris Basin, which is located at the end of Norton Road near 183 Norton Road, Johnstown, PA 15906 and beginning at **10:00 A.M.** on **Thursday, September 8, 2022**. Attendance at the pre-bid meeting is highly encouraged but is not mandatory.

The Owner reserves the right to reject any or all Bids, including without limitation, nonconforming, nonresponsive, unbalanced, or conditional Bids. Owner also reserves the right to waive all minor informalities not involving price, time, or changes in the Work.

ARTICLE 2 – BIDDER’S ACKNOWLEDGEMENTS

2.01 Bidder accepts all of the terms and conditions of the Instructions to Bidders, including without limitation those dealing with the disposition of Bid security. This Bid will remain subject to acceptance for 60 days after the Bid opening. If the award is delayed by the required approval of another government agency, the sale of bonds or the award of a grant, this Bid will remain subject to acceptance for 120 days after the Bid opening. B. Bidder has visited the Site, conducted a thorough, alert visual examination of the Site and adjacent areas, and become familiar with and satisfied itself as to the general, local, and Site conditions that may affect cost, progress, and performance of the Work.

D. Bidder has carefully studied all: (1) reports of explorations and tests of subsurface conditions at or adjacent to the Site and all drawings of physical conditions relating to existing surface or subsurface structures at the Site that have been identified in the Supplementary Conditions, especially with respect to Technical Data in such reports and drawings, and (2) reports and drawings relating to Hazardous Environmental Conditions, if any, at or adjacent to the Site that have been identified in the Supplementary Conditions, especially with respect to Technical Data in such reports and drawings.

Bidder agrees, based on the information and observations referred to in the preceding paragraph, that no further examinations, investigations, explorations, tests, studies, or data are necessary for the determination of this Bid for performance of the Work at the price bid and within the times required, and in accordance with the other terms and conditions of the Bidding Documents.
- G. Bidder is aware of the general nature of work to be performed by Owner and others at the Site that relates to the Work as indicated in the Bidding Documents.
- H. Bidder has given Engineer written notice of all conflicts, errors, ambiguities, or discrepancies that Bidder has discovered in the Bidding Documents and confirms that the written resolution thereof by Engineer is acceptable to Bidder.
- I. The Bidding Documents are generally sufficient to indicate and convey understanding of all terms and conditions for the performance and furnishing of the Work.

The submission of this Bid constitutes an incontrovertible representation by Bidder that Bidder has complied with every requirement of this Article, and that without exception the Bid and all prices in the Bid are premised upon performing and furnishing the Work required by the Bidding Documents.
