- 1. Bill No. 24 of 2022 - Petition to Abandon a Section of Galena Alley** - Residents attended the regular City Council meeting in November to ask for the abandonment of a section of Galena Alley in the Prospect neighborhood. City Council was in general agreement with the request. Staff subsequently evaluated the request and determined no adverse impact to City interests or residents.
