“Notice is hereby given that the City of Johnstown is considering entering into a contract with Sandyvale Cemetery Association under the City's Non-Profit Assistance CDBG Program. Gary Landis wishes to disclose he is the Vice President of the Sandyvale Cemetery Association and an employee of Advanced Business Design (ABD), which is a contracted engineer and third party UCC inspector for the City. Thus regulations which govern the Federal Community Development Block Grant (CDBG), requires the City to Provide full public disclosure to CDBG expenditures which may constitute conflicts of interest. Accordingly, the City will request Housing and Urban Development (HUD) to issue an exception to the regulatory conflict of interest prohibition.”
