RESOLUTION NO. 10576

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF JOHNSTOWN PENNSYLVANIA AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO EXECUTE AND TAKE ANY/ALL ACTIONS NECESSARY TO EFFECTUATE AN APPLICATION FOR FUNDING ASSISTANCE FROM THE PENNSYLVANIA COMMONWEALTH FINANCING AUTHORITY IN THE AMOUNT OF \$84,488.00 THROUGH THE GREENWAYS, TRAILS, AND RECREATION PROGRAM TO BE USED TOWARDS IMPROVEMENTS WITHIN ROXBURY PARK, LOCATED IN THE CITY OF JOHNSTOWN

WHEREAS, the Commonwealth Financing Authority assists local governments within the state of Pennsylvania to sustain and grow recreational assets, and

WHEREAS, the City Public Works Department is the responsible entity for the maintenance of all City parks, and

WHEREAS, it is the desire of the City Council to access funding opportunities to help us maintain our recreational assets; and

WHEREAS, the proposed project will include the resurfacing of the tennis courts, pickleball courts, and basketball courts within Roxbury Park; and

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Johnstown has agreed to submit a grant application to the Commonwealth Financing Authority and provide the required \$14,910.00 in matching funds.

NOW THEREFORE IT BE RESOLVED, that the City of Johnstown shall be, and the same hereby are authorized to submit a Grant Application to the Pennsylvania Commonwealth Financing Authority for the purpose of making improvements within Roxbury Park. The City Manager and/or his designee is hereby authorized to execute and take any/all actions necessary to effectuate all certifications and documentation required in connection with the application.
