A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF JOHNSTOWN, CAMBRIA COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA, APPROVING A LETTER OF INTEREST TO BE SUBMITTED TO THE PENNSYLVANIA EMERGENCY MANAGEMENT AGENCY

WHEREAS, the City of Johnstown is interested in proactive and collaborative stormwater management in the Greater Johnstown region; and

WHEREAS, Westmont Borough, Southmont Borough, Lower Yoder Township, and Geistown Boroughs, in partnership with the City of Johnstown, are also interested in cooperating in stormwater management, and seek the aid and expertise of the Pennsylvania Emergency Management Agency to better control stormwater and protect homes, businesses, and infrastructure; and

WHEREAS, the City of Johnstown and collaborating municipalities are interested in pursuing both Building Resilient Infrastructure, and Communities and Flood Mitigation Assistance grants to reduce the cost burden to City taxpayers for the installation and management of stormwater systems.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOVED, the City Council of the City of Johnstown directs and authorizes the City Manager and/or his designee to take any and all actions necessary to submit a letter of interest to the Pennsylvania Emergency Management Agency to explore stormwater management grant opportunities.
