A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF JOHNSTOWN, CAMBRIA COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO SIGN ALL DOCUMENTS NECESSARY TO EXECUTE AN AGREEMENT WITH SPORTS & RECREATION ASSOCIATES LLC., AWARDING THE CDBG 2023 PARK IMPROVEMENT PROJECT FOR FOREST AVENUE, SOMERSET STREET AND SANDYVALE PARKS

WHEREAS, the City of Johnstown Department of Community and Economic Development advertised and opened bids for the 2023 Parks project; and

WHEREAS, bids were advertised in the Tribune Democrat on July 28, 2023, and the bids were opened at 10:00 am on August 17, 2023; and

WHEREAS, Sports and Recreation Associates LLC. is the apparent low bidder for the CDBG 2023 Parks project, with at total price of \$391,300.00; and

WHEREAS, The City accepts the Base bid of \$79,087.50 for Contract # 2023-03 (Somerset Street), Base Bid plus the 4 alternates for an amount of \$302,412.50 for Contract # 2023-04 (Forest Avenue) and Base Bid \$9,800.00 for Contract # 2023-05 (Sandyvale)

WHEREAS, the City administration recommends the City Council accepts the said proposal for the CDBG 2023 Parks project in the amount of \$391,300.00 to be paid from the Community Development Block Grant account:
