RESOLUTION NO. 10610

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF JOHNSTOWN, CAMBRIA COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA, AUTHORIZING AND DIRECTING THE CITY MANAGER TO FACILITATE THE TRANSFER PROPERTY TO PENNDOT FOR THE GOUCHER STREET IMPROVEMENT PROJECT

WHEREAS, The Pennsylvania Department of Transportation intends to construct safety improvements along Goucher Street in Lower Yoder Township (the "Project"); and

WHEREAS, The City of Johnstown is the owner of Stackhouse Park, which lies adjacent to Goucher Street and the Project area located in Lower Yoder Township; and

WHEREAS, in order to properly widen Goucher Street during the Project, the Pennsylvania Department of Transportation needs to acquire 28,750 square feet of City owned property in Lower Yoder Township; and

WHEREAS, The Pennsylvania Department of Transportation will compensate the City of Johnstown \$2,200 for the property to be acquired for the Project.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Johnstown, that the City Manager is directed to proceed with transferring 28,750 square feet of property in Lower Yoder Township to the Pennsylvania Department of Transportation in order to complete safety improvements along Goucher Street.
