**Johnstown Housing Authority Grant Application -** The Johnstown Housing Authority is applying to the HUD Choice Neighborhood planning grant program to obtain \$500,000 for a study that will look at the future of public housing in the Coopersdale and Oakhurst neighborhoods. It is important to note the study does not obligate the City or any other organization to take specific actions. Rather, it is a planning study intended to provide an opportunity to gather community input, develop strategies and create a

vision for strengthening these two neighborhoods through improved housing, parks, transportation, stores and other amenities. Feedback from the US Department of Housing and Urban Development indicates that the City's formal participation will enhance the competitiveness of the application, and increase the likelihood of its approval.

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF JOHNSTOWN, CAMBRIA COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA AUTHORIZING A PARTNERSHIP WITH THE JOHNSTOWN HOUSING AUTHORITY TO APPLY FOR FUNIDNG FROM THE US DEPARTMENT OF HOUSING AND URBAN DEVELOPMENT CHOICE NEIGHBORHOOD PROGRAM
