AN ORDINANCE TO PARTIALLY VACATE AN ABANDONED ALLEY BETWEEN 152 AND 160 WESS STREET IN JOHNSTOWN, PENNSYLVANIA, AS A PUBLIC THOROUGHFARE.

WHEREAS, the property owner abutting the Abandoned Alley in the 17th Ward of the City of Johnstown, have petitioned the City Council of the City of Johnstown to partially vacate the abandoned alley between 152 and 160 Wess Street, and;

WHEREAS, there are no existing utilities within the Abandoned Alley, and;

WHEREAS, the property owner would maintain rights-of-way for the access to said utilities, and;

WHEREAS, the partial vacation of the Abandoned Alley between 152 and 160 Wess Street would not be adverse to the best interest of the public welfare of the City of Johnstown, Pennsylvania

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ENACTED AND ORDAINED, by the City Council of the City of Johnstown, Pennsylvania, and it is hereby enacted and ordained by the authority of the same as follows:

SECTION 1. That the Abandoned Alley between 152 and 160 Wess Street in the 17th Ward of the City of Johnstown is hereby partially vacated as a public thoroughfare.

SECTION 2. That the City of Johnstown is not liable for any utility or sewer relocation cost or any reuse cost incurred by the property owner.

SECTION 3. All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict herewith be and the same are hereby repealed insofar as they conflict herewith.

SECTION 4. This ordinance shall become effective upon final Passage.


