AN ORDINANCE FIXING THE SALARIES AND WAGES TO BE PAID ALL ELECTED OFFICIALS AND EMPLOYEES OF THE VARIOUS DEPARTMENTS AND BUREAUS OF THE CITY OF JOHNSTOWN FOR THE CALENDAR YEAR BEGINNING JANUARY 1, 2025.

BE IT ENACTED AND ORDAINED, by the Council of the City of Johnstown, Pennsylvania, and by the authority of the Council of the City of Johnstown, the City of Johnstown ordains this Salaries and Wage Ordinance:

SECTION 1. All amounts in this wage and salary ordinance shall be construed as the base pay of the individuals involved. All other benefits, i.e., sick leave, longevity, vacation, overtime pay, unused vacation pay, courtroom appearance pay, clothing allowance, etc., or other forms of compensation awarded in all legally executed contracts and/or negotiations between the City of Johnstown and its employees shall be considered separate compensation for the purpose of this Ordinance.

SECTION 2. That the salaries and wages to be paid all elected officials and employees of the City of Johnstown, from January 1, 2025 through December 31, 2025 shall not be in excess of the amounts and numbers as set forth in the charts that are attached hereto and incorporated herein by reference for the respective positions as herein authorized.
