NECESSARY IN THE PURCHASE OF OUTFITTING (2) POLICE CRUISERS AND (2)  
BUREAU OF CRIMINAL INVESTIGATION CRUISERS.**

**WHEREAS** the City of Johnstown Police Department is requesting the purchase of the outfitting of two Patrol Police Cruisers and two Bureau of Criminal Investigation Cruisers.

**WHEREAS** in the interests of detecting criminal activity, emergency response, transporting prisoners, and patrolling the jurisdiction of the City of Johnstown Police Department

**WHEREAS** the purchase of the outfitting of two Patrol Police Cruisers and two Bureau of Criminal Investigation Cruisers to support its mission, will be made from the Capital Fund, Account No. 18-410-72-025-00

**WHEREAS** the search for the outfitting of the four vehicles, found West Penn Vehicle Specialists, are highly qualified to fulfill the needs of the Johnstown Police Department;

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED**, by the City Council of Johnstown, Cambria County, Pennsylvania, that the City Manager and Finance Director are hereby authorized to sign all documents and take any/all other actions necessary to purchase the outfitting of said two Johnstown Police Patrol Cruisers and said two Johnstown Police Bureau of Criminal Investigation Cruisers at a cost of \$20,546.96.


