RESOLUTION NO. 10676

A RESOLUTION, of the City Council of the City of Johnstown, Pennsylvania, approving the award of HOME-ARP funds in the amount of \$374,841.50 to Victims Services, Inc. and authorizing the proper city officials to Execute all documents necessary to enter into an agreement.

WHEREAS, a request for funds was submitted by Victims Services, Inc. for HOME-ARP funds, and the project activity is eligible under the HUD HOME-ARP Guidelines; and

WHEREAS, these funds are to be used for the development of a non-congregate shelter for those fleeing domestic violence, dating violence, sexual assault, stalking, or human trafficking in the former American Red Cross Building on the corner of Vine and Walnut Streets; and

NOW, THEREFORE, be it resolved by the City Council of the City of Johnstown, Cambria County, Pennsylvania, and it is hereby resolved by the authority of the same, as follows:

SECTION 1. The City of Johnstown awards \$374,841.50 to Victims Services, Inc.

SECTION 2. That the appropriate City Officers are hereby authorized to enter into a contract with Victims Services, Inc. for the development of a non-congregate shelter for those fleeing domestic violence, dating violence, sexual assault, stalking, or human trafficking in the former American Red Cross Building on the corner of Vine and Walnut Streets.

SECTION 3. Any resolution, or part of any resolution, that may conflict herewith, or be repealed hereby, be and the same is hereby repealed.


