

## Resolution 10684

WHEREAS, the City of Johnstown is desirous to enter into a cooperative agreement with the Bottle Works Ethnic Arts Center, and

WHEREAS, the City of Johnstown recognizes the important work of the Bottle Works Ethnic Arts Center, and

WHEREAS, the Bottle Works Ethnic Arts Center has approached the City of Johnstown to formalize an in-kind agreement, not to exceed a value of twenty-five (\$2,500.00) dollars per annum or a total of ten thousand (\$10,000) dollars over the course of the four-year grant period to support a Pennsylvania Council of Arts Creative Communities grant, and

WHEREAS, the City of Johnstown supports this vision and initiative, be it

RESOLVED, that the City of Johnstown approves that the City Manager or their designee, at their discretion, provide the following in-kind support to the Bottle Works Ethnic Arts Center

- City Manager serving on the initiative's advisory council
- Provide street closures based on the adopted approval process of the City of Johnstown
- Providing space for meetings and/or reveal celebrations on City-controlled property based on the approval process of the City
- Public Works assistance as requested and within reason as determined by the City Manager or their designee.

The City of Johnstown will provide detailed in-kind invoicing to the Bottle Works Ethnic Arts Center reflecting the City's contribution(s) for each year for grant tracking and reporting.


